

BY CONTINUING TO MAKE A TEE TIME, YOU AGREE TO THE TERMS & CONDITIONS BELOW, AND ATTEST THAT YOU AND YOUR PLAYING PARTNERS ARE NOT EXPERIENCING ANY COVID-19 SYMPTOMS. IF YOU EXPERIENCE ANY COVID-19 SYMPTOMS PRIOR TO YOUR TEE TIME, YOU MUST STAY HOME AND CANCEL YOUR TEE TIME.

COMMON COVID-19 SYMPTOMS INCLUDE FEVER, TIREDNESS AND DRY COUGH. OTHER SYMPTOMS CAN INCLUDE ACHES & PAINS, NASAL CONGESTION, RUNNY NOSE, SORE THROAT AND DIARRHEA.

We trust you have been staying well amidst everything going on around us and are eagerly anticipating the opportunity to get back to golf. We have been diligently working behind the scenes to make extensive changes to our operation that will allow for a safe, enjoyable and comforting round of golf when the time is right. The health and safety of our customers and staff is of top priority to us, and we are here to provide ongoing updates as to what is happening at Flemington Park Golf Club.

The information below is designed to give a clear outlook as to what you can expect when you play a round of golf with us.

Social distancing of 2m/6ft is required AT ALL TIMES while on the property. This includes the parking lot, pro shop, all areas of the golf course – especially tee boxes and greens.

Provincial guidelines, legislation and fines apply while on the property, and must be strictly adhered to. Anyone failing to comply with social distancing, or any of the policies listed below, will be subject to being removed from the facility and further banned until all such policies have been lifted.

FACILITY & OPERATIONAL CHANGES

- Clubhouse will be closed to start the season, this includes the restaurant and washrooms, with exception of checking in at the Pro Shop.
- Only the two washrooms (portapotties) will be available on the entire property (near the 5th Tee Box).
- Bookings of 2, 3, or 4 golfers will be allowed. No single bookings at this time.
- Hand sanitizer stations will be available at the pro shop.
- All pull cart handles will properly be cleaned and disinfected before issued to another customer.
- Tee times will be at starters discretion to ensure proper spacing on the golf course and reduce the amount of traffic on the property, hence your tee time might not be exactly at the time you booked, sorry.
- First green must be cleared before next group Tee's off.
- Golfers are asked to please lay up on the 8th Green (please do not aim for the green).
- Our practice nets will be closed.
- Contact-less payment can be made at the pro shop.
- Club House will be closed, so there are no change room facilities or bathrooms available.

BEFORE YOU ARRIVE AT THE GOLF COURSE

- Due to limited tee times, all players must have a tee time before arriving at the golf course.
- Take advantage of email and/or call-in for booking.
- Ensure that you do not have COVID-19 related symptoms, haven't left the province within the last 14 days, and haven't come in contact with anyone that may have COVID-19. If any of these situations apply to you, STAY HOME.
- Plan to arrive at the course no more than 20 minutes before your round. This will help to drastically reduce the amount of traffic before your round.
- There will be no change rooms available, please come dressed with proper attire.

UPON ARRIVAL AT THE GOLF COURSE

- Large signage will greet you as you walk towards the clubhouse with instructions as to how to check-in and proceed with your round.
- Please ensure the group in front of you has left the 1st tee box before making your way there. All groups must wait until their assigned tee time NO EXCEPTIONS.

AFTER YOUR ROUND OF GOLF

- Maintain proper social distancing of 2m/6ft while unloading in the parking lot.
- Return your pull cart to the appropriate area (follow the signage) so it can be properly cleaned and sanitized.
- No congregating in the parking lot allowed. Please exit the facility upon returning your cart.

CHANGES TO YOUR GOLFING EXPERIENCE

- Social distancing of 2m/6ft must be maintained at ALL TIMES. this includes keeping your distance with all course maintenance staff.
- All high-touch areas have been removed – ball washers, and bunker rakes.
- Handshakes, high fives and any other touching gesture are not permitted before, during and after your round.
- Garbage cans will be available on the property.
- Only touch your own personal items – this includes golf balls, clubs and golf bags.
- Flag poles are to remain in the hole AT ALL TIMES. Spacers have been added to the cups so that you can easily remove your ball without touching anything else.
- You may pick up your ball when in a bunker to either improve your lie with your foot, or to play the ball from outside the bunker.
- All these guidelines are subject to change without notice, based on provincial updates.
